Mrs. Lisa, a resident of Lafayette, was the daughter of Terry Lambert and the former Gwynne Magnant. As a young woman, she and her family lived abroad. She graduated high school from the American School in Aberdeen, Scotland. Living in Aberdeen and traveling through Europe was one of the most special times of her life. After graduating from U.S.L. (now U.L.L.), Mrs. Lisa was an educator for numerous schools in the Acadiana area and was most recently a teacher at Comeaux High School for 20 years before her illness. She was the past president of the Louisiana High School Speech League and coached many speech and debate teams during her career. Mrs. Lisa was also a catechism teacher at St. Pius. She enjoyed traveling, attending musicals, and spending time at the beach, especially in RI where she was born and so loved. She would return there whenever she was able. Above all, the time spent with her children was her greatest joy in life. Mrs. Lisa was a loving and giving woman who never met a stranger. She will be dearly missed.

She is survived by her husband, James Jones; children, Ashlyn Elizabeth Jones and Terry "Jamie" James Jones; parents, Terry and Gwynne Ann Lambert, Jack and Val Grills; sister, Lauri Grills-Sauer; 2 brothers, Terry Lambert Jr. and Conward Lee Lambert.


