Mrs. Lytal, a resident of Lafayette, was the daughter of the late Walter Klein "Pappy" Boyd and the former Georgia Bollinger.

Mary Lynn Lytal was a graduate of Lockport High School, Nicholls State University and Louisiana State University with a Masters in Home Economics and Food Science. She taught at Lockport High, Central Lafourche and Larose High School. In the 70's, she retired from teaching to raise her children. She was a talented artist and seamstress and often taught summer art lessons to the neighborhood kids. She designed and created majorette uniforms for many years for her daughters and their team mates through junior high and high school. She was an advocate for adaptive teaching styles for children with Dyslexia and Learning Disabilities in the public-school system.

She was a prolific reader and historian and could answer any question you had with a factual, educated answer. She worked every crossword puzzle and read Dear Abby faithfully. She researched and documented her family genealogy dating back to the 1300's.

In the early 90's, Mary Lynn started an Environmental Business, and patented a microbial product, "Sewper Rx" which is distributed worldwide.

Mary Lynn moved to Lafayette, La in 2010 to be closer to her grandchildren. She loved her 2 poodles, Cupid and Bentley.

She is survived by her daughters, Gerilyn Lytal Roth (Matt) and Debra Anne Lytal; son, James True Lytal IV; granddaughters, Regan Elizabeth Roth (Davis Peltier) and Ashley Lytal Roth; grandson, Andre Matthew Roth; sister, Stephanie Boyd Mayet (Joe Paul); nieces, Lauren Mayet and Dr. Lindsay Mayet Lasseigne, MD (Jeff); great-niece, Georgia Lasseigne; and great-nephew, Gentry Lasseigne.
